Purpose

To establish mechanisms to assure compliance with the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) 29 CFR 1910.1200, which requires employers to provide information regarding hazardous chemicals to employees who may be exposed to such chemicals in the workplace.

Policy

All employees/students/researchers/visiting scientists, etc. who may be exposed to hazardous chemicals in the course of employment, education or research through any route of entry (inhalation, ingestion, skin contact, or absorption, etc.) and includes potential exposure under normal operating conditions or foreseeable emergencies shall have access to any and all information pertaining to the chemicals they work with or are exposed to.
